

## Samples of Gift Language (for use in a will or trust document)

your primary beneficiary has predeceased you.

For general purposes:
"I give <u>*[see below]</u> to the University of Massachusetts Amherst Foundation, tax ID# 54-2084125, for its general purposes."
To establish an expendable or endowed fund or contribute to an existing expendable/current use fund:
"I give <u>*[see below]</u> to the University of Massachusetts Amherst Foundation, tax ID# 54-2084125, for the <u>[name of fund]</u> fund to be used as set forth in a separate gift agreement with the University of Massachusetts Amherst."
To contribute to an existing endowed fund:
"I give *[see below] to the University of Massachusetts Amherst Foundation, tax ID# 54-2084125, for the[name of fund] fund at the University of Massachusetts Amherst."
To give to a specific program or unit:
"I give *[see below] to the University of Massachusetts Amherst Foundation, tax ID# 54-2084125, for at The University of Massachusetts, Amherst."
*A specific asset may be named: You can leave a specific dollar amount or a specific asset (e.g., specific dolla amount, specific stock, real estate, tangible personal property, intellectual property, etc.).
<b>Percentage of residuary estate clause:</b> You can leave a specific percentage of the assets remaining in your estate <i>after</i> all of the debts and expenses of the estate have been paid, and after all specific bequests have been satisfied.
"I give percentage ( %) of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate to the University of Massachusetts Amherst Foundation, tax ID# 54-2084125."
<b>Entire residuary estate clause</b> : You can leave the <i>entire</i> balance remaining in your estate <i>after</i> all of the debts and expenses of the estate have been paid, and after all specific bequests have been satisfied.
"I give, devise and bequest the rest residue and remainder of my estate to the University of Massachusetts Amherst Foundation, tax ID# 54-2084125."

"In the event that my (spouse, daughter, son, friend – use full name) shall predecease me, I give to the University of Massachusetts Amherst Foundation, tax ID# 54-2084125."

Note: These are samples of bequest language to meet your gifting intentions. It is important that you seek the assistance and guidance of your estate planning attorney. Most jurisdictions allow for incorporation by reference of a gift agreement if the gift agreement is in place prior to the execution of the will.

Contingency provision clause: You can name UMass Amherst to be a substitute beneficiary in the event that
